Cubano Romeo y Julieta

Straw yellow colour with green reflections, bouquet of complex aromas of fruit and white flesh. intense with hints of white fruit and floral aftertaste. Excellent with cheese, seafood, white meats and at the end of a meal.

Is the most popular cigar on the world market. In 2004, the Edmundo was introduced, a large robust cigar named after the hero of Dumas' novel The Count of Montecristo, Edmond Dantès.

Trinidad

A clear colour that releases an almost elusive leather aroma. The entire smoke is played on soft herbaceous, woody and almond notes, which are joined - from the second third onwards - by hints of leather and vanilla.

Cuaba

Its dense, enveloping smoke provides long-lasting persistence. The opening is sweet, with light notes of leather and pink pepper. The first tercio begins with aromas of hazelnut, dried fruit and a little earth. Between one puff and the next, vegetal, almost forest-like hints also emerge.
